Owner of Monument which is a Castle known as CASTLE TIORAM lying at the north-west of a small Island known as Eilean Tirim, the whole of said Island being included within the scheduled area as shown coloured red on the map annexed and being the subjects described in a Disposition granted by Executors of James Wiseman Macdonald and another in favour of James Wiseman Macdonald, Junior dated 31st May and 7th June and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Inverness 29th July all 1946 and

situated in the Parish of Ardnamurchan and
County of Inverness.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, as read with the Transfer of Functions (Scottish Royal Parks and Ancient Monuments) Order, 1969, the Secretary of State hereby gives notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

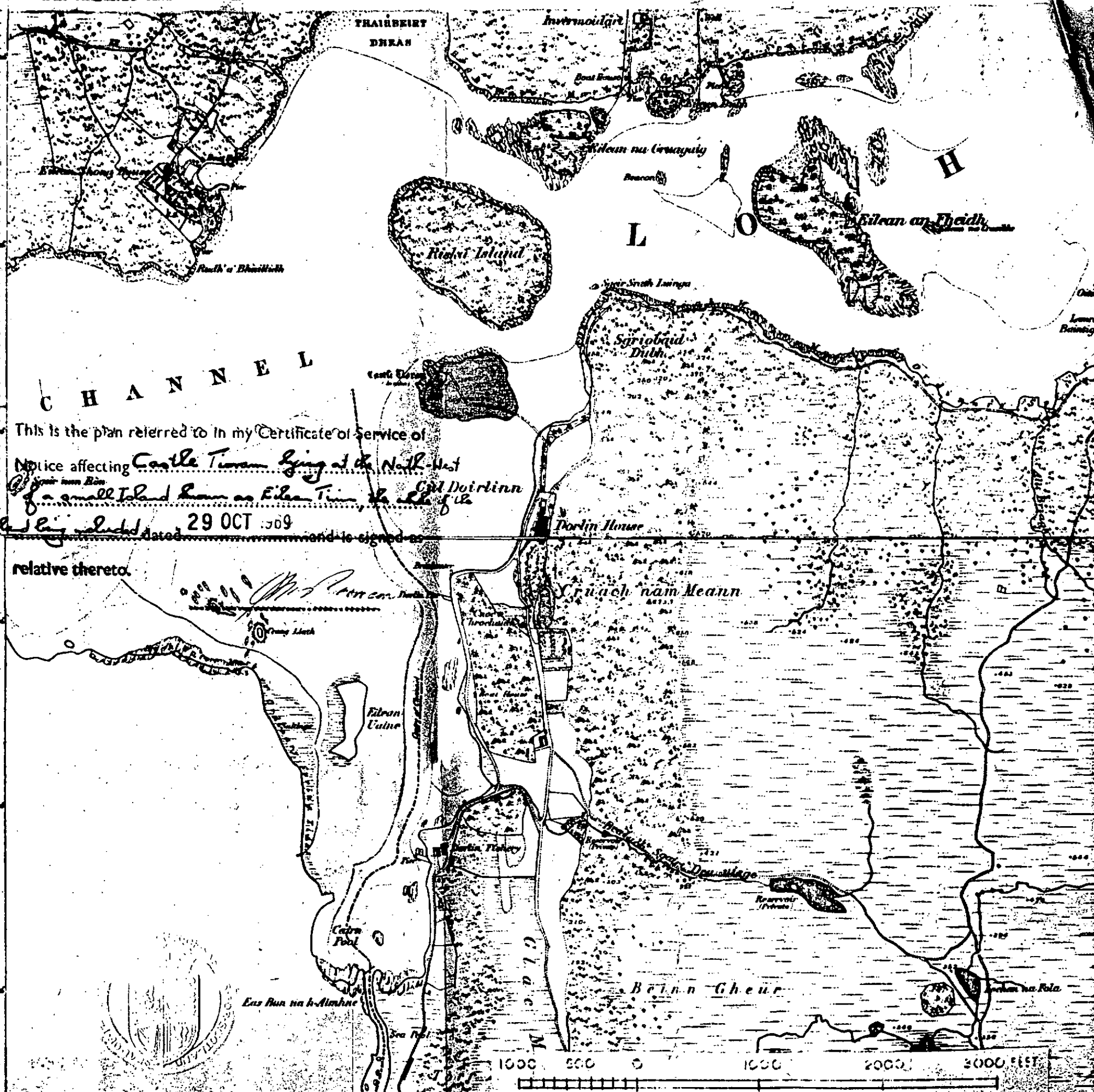
