1. Sacred to the memory of **MARY LIVINGSTONE** wife of **JOHN MACLEAN**, Tresleig, who died 8 June 1893, aged 60 years. Also their children, **JOHN**, who died 1855, aged 5 weeks, **CHARLES**, died, 1860, aged 7 years, **ANNE** died 1861 aged 3 years. **JESSIE GILLANDERS**, wife of **CHARLES MACLEAN**, died 9 May, 1940. R.I.P. **CHARLES MACLEAN**, died 7 February, 1959. R.I.P.
- ✓ 2. 1845. Of your charity pray for the soul of **CHRISTIE McLEAN** wife of **HECTOR McCOLL**, Achpobuil, who died 24 February 1845 aged 42 years. R.I.P.
- ✓ 3. Here lyes the remains of **ANNE MACKENZIE**, spouse to **JOHN ANDERSON**, who died 4th day of March 1817, aged 70 years.
4. In memory of **ALEXANDER MACLEAN** died 21 February 1971 aged 72 years, husband of **CATHERINE MACPHERSON**.
5. This stone placed here **HECTOR McCOLL**, Achphuble.
- ✓ 6. This stone is placed here by **ALEXANDER McCOLL**, tenant, Achphuble, 1820.
- ✓ 7. This stone is placed here by **DUGALD MACDOUGALD**, in memory of his brother son (sic) **DONALD MCDUGALD** who departed this life at Trisleig, the 6 December 1822, aged 28 years and his spouse **CHRISTIAN MACMILLAN**.
- ✓ 8. This stone is placed here in memory of **JOHN MACDOUGALD**, late tenant at Ishiruidhe who departed this life the 17th day of April 1805 aged 50 years and his spouse **FLORY MacCALLUM**. This is done by the order of **DOUGALD MACDOUGALD**, his brother. (Carved at the foot of the slab is a very fine hour glass and a small coffin.)
9. Sacred to the memory of **ALEXANDER MACLEAN** who died 19th December 1862, aged 65 years.

17. In loving memory of **JOHN BOYD** who died at 10 Blaich, 3 January, 1892, aged 57 years, also his wife, **ISABELLA MACGREGOR**, who died 22 April, 1910, aged 78 years. Their eldest son **DUNCAN** died at 11 Blaich, 5 March 1934, aged 77 years. Erected by the family.

18. Erected by **MALCOLM KENNEDY** in memory of his niece, **CATHERINE MORRISON**, who died 7 June, 1888, aged 44 years. **MALCOLM KENNEDY**, Achnacree, Benderloch, died at Connel, 3 June, 1906.

20. Erected by his family in loving memory of **EWEN KENNEDY** who died at Achnacree, Benderloch, 26 May 1903, aged 69 years, also his sons, **JOHN** who died at Achnacree 25 June 1888 aged 9 years, **EWEN**, who died at Timaru. N.Z. 21 June 1950.

✓ 21. This stone is erected here in memory of **MARY MacBEAN** who departed this life the 30th day of October 1803 aged 19th (sic) years. This stone is done by the order of her father **JOHN McBEAN**, tacksman in Druimfern.

22. Sacred to the memory of **CHARLES MACDONALD** who died at Clobhulin 5 December, 1825, aged 42 years. **ANN BOYD** his wife, this is done by order of their son **EWEN**. [Reverse] C.M.D

✓ 23. This stone is placed here in memory of **ALLAN MACLEAN**, late tenant at Aonie Beag in Morvin who departed this life the 24 day of March 1803, aged 59 years and **MARGARET MACLEAN** his spouse. And this is done by the order of their son **EWEN MACLEAN** at Camusashig.

✓ 25. Here lyes the remains of **ANNE MCDONELL**, daughter to **DONALD MCDONELL**, Fort William, who departed this life the 20th of May 1802, aged 21 years and 4 months. R.I.P.

✓ 26. Erected by **ALEXANDER MACPHERSON**, road contractor, Gerradh, Ardgour, in memory of his wife and three sons, 1851. [Reverse] A.M.P.

✓ 27. Here lyes the remains of **ALLAN MACLEAN**, late tenant at Blaich, who departed this life the 18th day of January 1832 aged 58 years. This stone placed here by his spouse **CATHERINE MACPHERSON**.

✓ 29. Here lyes the remains of **HUGH MACLEAN** son to **ARCHIBALD MACLEAN**, Corran, who departed this life the year 1792 aged 5 months.

32. Here lyes the body 18 Blaich 94 In memory of **SARAH BOYD** died March 1859 aged 44 years also **MARY** her daughter died 1885 aged 40 years. (Two different types of lettering)

✓ 33. Here lyes the body of **ALEXANDER LIVINGSTONE**, son of **JOHN LIVINGSTONE**, in Fort William, who departed this life 3 May 1791 aged 13 months and one week.

✓ 34. To the memory of **MALCOLM BOYD**, late tenant Drimfern, who departed this life on the 1st June 1803, aged 65 years.

35. In loving memory of **MALCOLM BOYD**, late farmer Achnacon, Appin, who died at Ballymeanach, Mull, 12 August 1892, aged 83 years, also his wife **CHRISTINA CAMERON** died at Lochnell Cottage, Ledaig, 21 January 1891, aged 67 years and their grandson **DUGALD CAMERON** died at Achnacon, October 1882, aged 10 years, also their son, **JOHN** died at Toraphocain Farm. Glencreran, 19 April, 1923, aged 65 years. Erected by the family 1893.

✓ 36. Erected by **DONALD MACLEAN** in memory of his mother **JEAN MACLEAN** who died at Clovulin on 21 August 1846 aged 48 years also her husband **ALEXANDER MACLEAN** died 27 January 1867 aged 86 years.

37. This stone is placed here for and in memory of **MALCOM [sic] MACLEAN** who departed this life aged 59 years May 30th 1796.

✓ 38. Sacred to the memory of **MARION MACKENZIE** spouse of **ALEXANDER MACDONALD** who died June 1818 aged 71 years and whose later end was worthy of the life she had led that of a sincere and most exemplary Christian. This stone is placed here by their daughter **MARY MACDONALD** A.D.1840. Also **ALEXANDER LIVINGSTONE**, son of **HUGH LIVINGSTONE** and **MARION MACDONALD** who died 11 April 1841 aged 27.

✓ 39. This stone is placed here for and in memory of **SANDY MACLEAN** who departed this life aged 58 years 1794.

✓ 42. Here rests the remains of **EWEN MACLACHLAN** M.A. Rector of the Grammar School of Aberdeen died the 29th March 1822 aged 47 years. A memorial obelisk erected by his ?countrymen is in the Craigs at Fort William. [Reverse; erected by his grand nephews, the sons of **EWEN** and **SARAH STEWART MACPHEE**, Fort William.

✓ 43. This stone is placed here by **DONALD MACLACHLAN**, Fort William, in memory of **SARAH MACKENZIE**, his spouse, who departed this life the 10th November 1862 aged 61 years and their three lawful children who departed this life the year 1780.

44. Here lie **D.LAC**.

45. Here lies the body of **JOHN MACLACHLAN**.

✓ 47. ANNO DOMINI 1815. This stone is erected by **DONALD MACLACHLAN**, shepherd, Creigbheachan, in memory of his spouse **MARY MACMILLAN** who departed this life the 10th day of August ANNO 1814, aged 86 years. [Underneath a very fine hour glass and coffin followed by "Life how short, eternity how long" and another piece of script I have yet to decipher) ending in five lines of Gaelic script.

52. Sacred to the memory of **ANDREW MACFARLANE**, managing shepherd who died at Duiskey, Ardgour, on the 29th September 1858. Erected by his sorrowing widow **ANN KENNEDY**, 1861.

✓ 53. This stone is placed here by **ANGUS KENNEDY** to perpetuate the memory of his father **JOHN KENNEDY**, late tenant at Blaich who departed this life 19 day of July 1818 aged 56 years. [Beneath this is a very elaborate armorial achievement with supporters which I have photographed. Motto AVICE LA FIN]

54. **H. BOYD**

55. Erected to the memory of **DUNCAN BOYD**, farmer Stronchreggin who died 26 October, 1880 aged 84 years. Also his wife, **ISABELLA KENNEDY** who died at Glenshellach, 18 April, 1887, aged 74 years. And their children, **JOHN**, died 8 July, 1865, aged 20 years, **NEIL**, died 22 September, 1876, aged 42 years, **ALEXANDER**, died 18th October, 1881, aged 49 years.

✓ 56. Sacred to the memory of **JOHN CAMERON** and his spouse **ELIZABETH CAMERON**, both died at Fort William, the former, 18th July 1825, aged 83 years and the latter on the 24th February 1819 aged 70 years and of their son Lt **DONALD CAMERON** of the Rifle Brigade who died at Fort William on the 27th February 1814 aged 26 years also of their grandson **DUNCAN CAMERON** who died at Fort William 31 July 1841 aged 20 years. [Reverse] Erected as a tribute of respect for his departed friends by Capt **ALEXANDER CAMERON**. Carnoch, Strontian. 1846. (At the foot of the stone is inscribed K.McK. fecit.

57. A.C.

✓ 58. Here lyes the remains of **DUGALD MACLACHLAN**, residenter at Fort William, who departed this life the 4th December 1810 aged 73 years.

✓ 59. This stone is placed here by his afflicted spouse **CATHERINE MACLACHLAN** over the remains of her husband **ANGUS MACLACHLAN** who perished opposite Fort William the 15th August 1808 aged 38 years.

✓ 60. This stone is placed for and in memory of **MURDOCH MACLEAN** and **CATHERINE MACMILLAN** his spouse, 1784.

61. In memory of **ANGUS KENNEDY** who died at Inverfolla, Appin, February 24th 1890 aged 62 years, also his son **JAMES**, died November 1879 aged 14 years.

62. 1925 (sic) but by the style I think the date should be 1825) In loving memory of **JOHN KENNEDY** died at Ichrachan, Taynult, 11 January 1917, aged 77 years. Erected by the family.

63. Erected by **DONALD KENNEDY** in memory of his beloved wife **MARJORY MACPHEE** who died on the 17th day of June 1875 aged 52 years also to the memory of **DONALD KENNEDY** who died at Blarmafoldach, 12 September 1896 aged 76 years.

64. In memory of **JOHN MACLEAN** who died at Cuil, Ardgour, on the 25th October 1861, aged 32 years. Erected by his sorrowing widow **MARGARET MACINNES**.

✓ 65. By **JOHN PENDER**, joiner Glasgow, in memory of his daughter **ELIZA CHRISTIE**, who died at Cuil, August 2, 1827 aged 4 months. [Reverse] an open book uninscribed.

67. In affectionate remembrance of **JOHN, FLORA and ANN MACLACHLAN** who died at Achintore in 1853 also of **EWEN MACLACHLAN** their father who died in 1858 and **FLORA MACLACHLAN** his spouse who died 2nd July 1855 aged 87 years also of their sons **ALEXANDER** who died 4 May 1867, aged 73 and **ARCHIBALD** who died 10 December 1871 aged 76 and of their daughters, **JANE** who died 14 January, 1875, aged 65 and of **DUNCAN** who died 18 July 1876, aged 75 years. Erected by **HUGH MACLACHLAN**, son and brother of the above. "The Lord gave and the Lord hath taken away. Blessed be the name of the Lord. Job.1.21 [Reverse] H.M.L. (At the foot of the stone - K. Mc.K. Fecit)

68/69/70: Three armorial table tombs thought to belong to the Macleans of Ardgour. Badly weathered and yet to be deciphered..

72. Sacred to the memory of **ALEXANDER THOMAS MACLEAN** 15th Laird of Ardgour who passed away in his sleep 14 December 1890 in his 56th year. Also of his wife, **SELINA PHILLIPA DICKEN**, who died 12 March 1909 and was laid here beside him. And of their eldest daughter **CATHERINE HELLEN DALRYMPLE** died 12 February 1947.

[Reverse] Also of **ALEXANDER MACLEAN** 13th Laird of Ardgour died 8 September 1855 aged 91 years and **LADY MARGARET MACLEAN**, his wife, 3rd daughter of **JOHN, 2nd EARL OF HOPETOUN**. Died 16 September 1831 aged 59 years. Also of **ALEXANDER MACLEAN** 14th Laird of Ardgour died 28 November 1872 aged 73 years and **HELEN JANE**, his wife, eldest daughter of **SIR J DALRYMPLE**, 5th Baronet of North Berwick. Died 4 January 1882, aged 74 years.

73. To the memory of **ALEXANDER JOHN HEW MACLEAN OF ARDGOUR** 16th Laird born 1880 died 1930. His wife **MURIEL BURNS**, daughter of 3rd **BARON INVERCLYDE**. Born 1893 died 1969. Their loving daughter **CATRIONA LOUISE MACLEAN OF ARDGOUR**. Born 1919 died 1988.
