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"NN 7643 9977 Ruthven Barracks (in ruins). On site of Ruthven Castle."(1) "The site is an alluvial mound. There was a fortress on it during the 14th c. and probably earlier. In the 16th c., another castle was built here; this was destroyed in 1689 but seems to have been rebuilt before 1715. The Barracks were erected by the government in 1718 for a garrison, but were burnt by fugitives from Culloden in 1746 and never repaired. No trace of the earlier works survived."(2)(3) "Ruthven Barracks, generally as described and planned by MacGibbon and Ross, now being restored by the MOW."(OSFI:NKB:31.10.1967) "NN 7643 9977, remains of Ruthven Barracks (1718), on site of castle."(4) "See continuation card for illustration and plan."
